Before attempting to connect or operate this product, please read these instructions carefully and save this manual for future use.

The model number is abbreviated in some descriptions in this manual.

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Features

The WV-ASR500 Series (hereinafter this software) is a software that runs on the Microsoft® Windows® operating system and enables recording the images from multiple network cameras on the hard disk drives of the personal computer (hereinafter PC).

By using this software, it is possible to display live images of the cameras on the monitor of the remote client PC, to play images stored on the hard disk drive on the monitor of the remote client PC by operating the client PC, or to download image files to the hard disk drive of the client PC.

When the Adobe[®] Reader[®] is not installed on the PC, download the latest Adobe[®] Reader[®] from the Adobe web site and install it.

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Network security

As you will use this product connected to a network, your attention is called to the following security risks.

- 1 Leakage or theft of information through this product
- 2 Use of this product for illegal operations by persons with malicious intent
- 3 Interference with or stoppage of this product by persons with malicious intent

It is your responsibility to take precautions such as those described below to protect yourself against the above network security risks.

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System requirements for a PC

It is recommended to install this software on a PC that meets the following system requirements.

OS*1: Microsoft® Windows Server® 2012 (64-bit)*2

OS language: English, French, Spanish, German, Italian, Russian, Chinese

CPU: Intel[®] Xeon[®] E5-2630 (2.30 GHz/6-core/15 MB/95 W)

Memory: 16 GB or more

Interface: 1000 Mbps Network interface card must be installed

When the display style or the font size is changed from the default, it may be possible that the layout of this software collapses.

*2 Operates in WOW64 (32-bit mode).

Important:

- This software must be installed by the administrator. Otherwise, any problems will not be covered
 by the warranty.
- · Servers should use fixed IP addresses.
- Automatic updating of operating-system should be disabled, otherwise your server might stop recording video when the operating-system restarts.
- Operation of this software on remote desktop is not guaranteed.
- While running this software, do not log out of the PC nor shut down the PC. Otherwise, operation
 of this software may become unstable.
- Do not use other applications, especially heavy load types, while this software is running.
 Otherwise, the CPU overload and the shortage of resources will cause malfunction and insufficient performance.
- When no sound card is installed, the buzzer will not sound at an alarm/error occurrence. The audio transmission/reception function is also unavailable.
- Use of 2-byte characters for a user name causes installation failure. Create a user name with 1-byte alphanumeric characters and perform installation.

Installation

- 1. Double-click the installer.
 - → The installers of "Server", "Client", and "Web Service" will be launched.

 Install this software by following the instructions displayed on the monitor.

 When installing the "Client", uncheck the "Run ASR500 Series Client".

 When installing the "Web Service", uncheck the "Configure ASR500 Series Web Service".

Important:

- When reinstallation is necessary, uninstall the existing software before starting the reinstallation. An overwrite installation may cause unstable operations.
- The "Security Warning" window may appear, however it is not a problem. Continue with installation process.

Launching the Client

 Press the [Windows] key to display the Start Menu of the OS, and then click the "ASR500 Series Client" icon.

Important:

 When using this software, be sure to register the "License Key". Refer to the Activation Key Card for further information about how to obtain the "License Key".

Uninstallation

- 1. Open "Uninstall a Program" in "Control Panel".
- Select "Client" from the presently installed programs and click the [Uninstall] button.
 - → The uninstall program will be launched and the wizard will be displayed.
- 3. Uninstall this software by following the instructions displayed on the monitor.
- 4. Select "Server", and uninstall it in the same way as in steps 2 and 3.
- 5. Select "Web Service", and uninstall it in the same way as in steps 2 and 3.

Important:

- When uninstalling this software, it is selectable whether to retain the settings.
- When a message window is displayed in the process of the uninstallation to ask you to quit the
 applications, click the [Yes] button. The application will be terminated first, and then this software
 will be uninstalled.
 - Refer to the operating instructions of the OS in use for how to stop the services.
- The "Security Warning" window may appear, however it is not a problem. Continue with uninstallation process.
