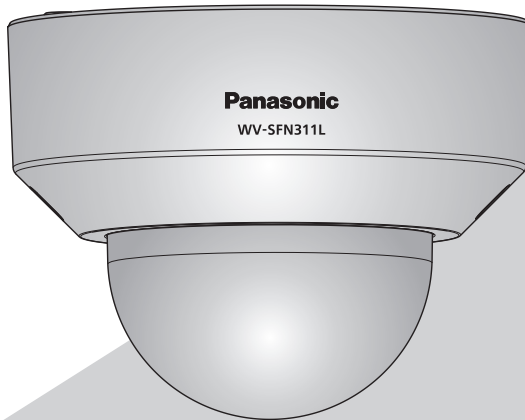

# Preface

The network camera WV-SFN311L is designed to operate using a PC on a network (10BASE-T/100BASE-TX).

By connecting to a network (LAN) or the Internet, images and audio from the camera can be monitored on a PC via a network.

**Note:**

- It is necessary to configure the network settings of the PC and its network environment to monitor images from the camera on the PC. It is also necessary to install a web browser on the PC.

## Main functions

### Equipped with a new codec engine

The redesigned codec engine can output up to 60 frames per second in HD quality.

### Equipped with an enhanced Super Dynamic function and widened dynamic range to 133 dB

By combining images taken at different shutter speeds and using pixel level brightness correction, more natural looking pictures can be taken even when objects have large differences in illumination.

\* Super Dynamic function is automatically set Off on 60 fps mode.

### Equipped with a high-sensitivity MOS sensor and noise reduction function (MNR)

The high-sensitivity sensor and new method of noise reduction (MNR: Multi-process Noise Reduction)<sup>\*1</sup> make it possible to take easy-to-view images even under low illumination conditions.

<sup>\*1</sup> With the multi-process noise reduction that prioritizes noise reduction for central areas and resolution for edge areas where noise is prominent, MNR is able to produce clear images while limiting noise across the entire image.

### IR LED equipped

The equipped infrared LED makes it possible to take pictures at zero lx of objects as far as 30 m {98.43 feet} away.

### Equipped with 1 SD memory card<sup>\*2</sup> slot and enhanced image recording

- By using SD memory card, images can be recorded over long periods of time.

<sup>\*2</sup> SDXC/SDHC/SD memory card is described as SD memory card.

### Easy installation with the attachment plate, motorized zooming, and basic adjustment functions<sup>\*3</sup>.

Installation can be performed easily by rotating the camera with the attachment plate that can adjust the camera's position in 90° increments. The motorized zoom and automatic basic focus adjustment make it possible to reduce the time required for making adjustments.

<sup>\*3</sup> A function that automatically and easily adjusts the focus when the angle of view is adjusted.

(Final adjustments must be made by pressing the AF button.)

Before turning off the camera power switch, make sure that the SD MOUNT indicator (green) is turned off. If you turn off the camera power switch while the SD MOUNT indicator (green) is lit or flashing, the recorded data may be corrupted or damaged.

**Handle this product with care.**

Do not drop this product, nor apply shock or vibration to the product. Failure to observe this may cause trouble.

**Do not touch the dome cover with your bare hands.**

A dirty dome cover causes deterioration of picture quality.

**About the PC monitor**

When displaying the same image on the monitor for a long time, the monitor may be damaged. It is recommended to use a screen-saver.

**When an error is detected, this product will restart automatically.**

This product will be inoperable for around 2 minutes after the restart just as when the power is turned on.

### **About the automatic status detection function**

When this product malfunctions due to exogenous noise, etc. for 30 seconds or more, the product will automatically reset and will return to normal state. When the product is reset, initialization will be carried out as when the power of the product is turned on. When the product repeatedly resets, exogenous noise level around the product may be high and that may cause malfunction. Contact your dealer for instructions.

### **Transmission interval**

Image transmission interval may become slow depending on the network environment, PC performance, shooting subject, access number, etc.

### **Periodically images on the screen appear to be distorted**

When the camera is installed in a location where it is subject to small vibrations (for example, when it is installed near devices that vibrate), images may appear distorted and stretched lengthways. This phenomenon is a characteristic of image pickup devices that use CMOS sensors and is caused by the relationship between the periodic movements of the camera and the timing that the image sensor reads images. This is not a problem with the camera. To reduce the possibility of this phenomenon occurring, install the camera in a secure location.

### **About SD memory card**

- To remove the SD memory card, hold down the SD ON/OFF button for about 2 seconds. When the flashing SD MOUNT lamp goes out, you can remove the SD memory card.
- When using an SD memory card, format it using this product. Recorded data on the SD memory card will be deleted when formatted. If an unformatted SD memory card or an SD memory card formatted with other devices is used, this product may not work properly or performance deterioration may be caused. Refer to the

Operating Instructions on the provided CD-ROM for how to format an SD memory card.

- When some SD memory cards are used with this product, the product may not work properly or performance deterioration may be caused. Use the SD memory cards recommended in page 22.

### **About the MOS image sensor**

- When continuously shooting a bright light source such as a spotlight, the color filter of the MOS image sensor may become deteriorated and this may cause discoloration. Even when changing the fixed shooting direction after continuously shooting a spotlight for a certain period, the discoloration may remain.
- When shooting fast-moving subjects or objects crossing the shooting area may look to be bending askew.

### **About the “Day & Night(IR)” function**

When the “Day & Night(IR)” is set to ON and the “Adjusting method” to “Auto”, the focus may be off depending upon the condition of the photographic subject. If this happens, set the “Adjusting method” to “Preset” and use either auto or manual to focus. The camera is able to remember the focus position. For information about performing the “Day & Night(IR)” setting, refer to the Operating Instructions (included in the CD-ROM).

### **Cleaning this product body**

Be sure to turn off the power before cleaning. Failure to observe this may cause injury. Do not use benzine, thinner, alcohol, or any other types of solvents or detergents. Otherwise, it may cause discoloration. When using a chemical cloth for cleaning, read the caution provided with the chemical cloth product.

### **Cleaning the lens**

Use a lens cleaning paper (used to clean camera lenses or lenses of spectacles). When using solvent, use an alcohol solvent and do not use a thinner or a glass cleaner.

## **Cleaning of the internal and external parts of the dome cover**

Dirt or fingerprints on the dome cover may greatly affect the quality of pictures taken at night. Therefore, remove any dirt from the dome cover by using cleaning paper or other products. If there are marks left on the inside of the dome cover from the light-blocking rubber ring, remove any marks from the dome cover by using cleaning paper or other products.

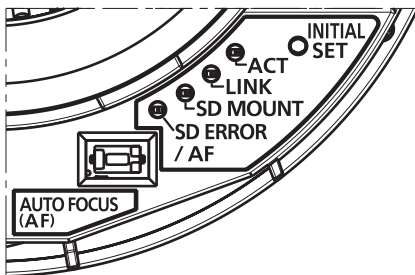
